BACKGROUND

Immunoglobulin G (IgG), is one of the most abundant proteins in human serum which constitutes 75% of serum immunoglobulins, IgG is produced by B lymphocytes as a part of our adaptive immune response. The IgG molecule has two separate functions; to bind to the pathogen that elicited the response and to recruit other cells and molecules to destroy the antigen through Antibody-dependent cell-mediated cytotoxicity (ADCC) effection.


